Dear students of the Academy of Media Arts Cologne,

You can apply for the Germany Scholarship from now until February 18, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. To be eligible, you must have at least two semesters of study remaining (up to and including the 2026 summer semester). The scholarship period covers six months from April 2026 to September 2026 inclusive, due to the start date at the KHM Cologne.

Seven scholarships are expected to be awarded. Two of these will be earmarked for “technical proximity or orientation of the artistic approach (e.g., animation, 3D animation, aesthetics, and new technologies)” and two for artistic photography.

Please submit the following documents in full with your application:

1. Up-to-date tabular resume
2. Data sheet with the following information: student ID number, first and last name, registered address, KHM email address, BAföG approval yes/no, first-time application yes/no?
3. Letter of motivation
4. Digital portfolio of artistic work as a PDF file.
5. The three forms for providing evidence of social engagement, awards, and biographical hurdles.
